We have been notified that one of our students attending Summer Weights at USD 386 has been exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19, commonly known as “Coronavirus,” based on test results obtained on July 20th, 2020.

We are alerting you to this development because, based on the District’s investigation, we believe that you may have come into contact with the case, on or about July 20th. We would highly recommend that you self-quarantine and monitor yourself for symptoms. In the interim, we encourage you to seek medical advice, communicate with the Greenwood County Health Department, and a possible COVID-19 test, especially if you are exhibiting symptoms of the virus.

As a precaution we are closing our weight facility for 14 day starting July 21st. Please inform Greenwood County Health Department if any of the following occur during your self-quarantine: you experience flu-like symptoms, including fever, cough, sneezing, or sore throat; or you test positive for COVID-19.

We are committed to providing a safe environment for all of our students and employees and service to our community. It is in the interest of those goals that we provide this information out of an abundance of caution.

We also want to take this opportunity to remind you that one of our core values as a district is respect for and among our students and employees. We will treat information regarding the identity of individuals with suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19 as confidential to the extent feasible and will comply with applicable laws regarding the handling of such information. Further, per District policy, we will not tolerate harassment of, or discrimination or retaliation against, employees or students
