PURPOSE

Making a difference in the educational opportunities for recent MHS graduates is the primary purpose of the Madison Educational Assistance Fund

SCHOLARSHIPS

Endowed & Memorial: Currently, there are now 41 endowed scholarships. With a minimum contribution of \$2,000, an endowed scholarship or memorial scholarship in the donors name can be established and given each year to a graduating senior of Madison High School. With endowed scholarships, only the interest is used each year. Other memorial and gift contribution scholarships may also be given.

The 200 Club: In order to increase the opportunities for involvement in direct financial support, the Madison Educational Assistance Fund (MEAF) launched a community-wide endowment program in 1998 titled **The 200 Club**. The program's goal is to raise a minimum of 200 memberships contributing \$200 (or more). Currently there are currently 115 memberships, and when fully funded the program will establish a minimum \$40,000 permanent 200 Club Endowed Scholarship. A member of the 200 Club can be an individual, an organization or club, a business, a group of individuals, or a family. Memberships can also be established as a memorial, or in appreciation for someone or some group.

Current memberships of the 200 Club, along with current endowed scholarships, memorials and gift contributions are listed on temporary framed certificates displayed at Madison High School, and frequently displayed in other locations for special events such as the Madison Days reunion dinner.
