The Anne Frank Foundation or Anne Frank stitching is a foundation in the Netherlands originally established to maintain the Anne Frank House in Amsterdam. The exhibition has been translated into several languages and tells the story of Anne Frank against the background of the persecution of the Jews in the WWII. This foundation also advocates the fight against antisemitism and racism and publishes the Dutch annual Monitor Racism en Extreem-rechts (Monitor Racism and Extreme Right), in which the activities of present day racists are studied. Anne wrote in her diary while hiding in occupied holland.
